

INSTRUCTIONS: CARD "FLOWER ARRANGEMENT"

Inks: Leaf green 10T(1213), Blue 02T(1205), White and Gold.

PCE 3 - 13 – 16. Yellow, Blue, Green. Paintbrush 1 or 2

Perforating Straight Grid and medium or fine Grid. (Pergamano)

Basic tool kit.

Trace rectangle in white pencil.

Place onto Straight grid and emboss border according to pattern. For perforating the holes in between embossing turn paper over and place on grid again. Don't forget to perforate along the outside of border on three sides only. (One side is fold). Take vellum of grid and draw a fold line with white pencil.

Position border over pattern to trace flowers.

Large petals in white, small flowers in blue and leaves in green. Centre of all flowers and dotted lines in gold.

Emboss: in feather style all flower petals towards the centre. The same for small leaves.

Large leaves in between veins. Emboss gold dots and center of small flowers.

On back paint with PCE 13 small flowers, with PCE3 centre of large flowers (front and back) small leaves with PCE16. For large leaves on back make a line on inner side of leaves with PCE3 and fill in with PCE16. With damp brush let both colours flow into each other.

Position vellum on medium or fine grid and perforate every hole to form diamond shape behind flowers. You could draw the shape with white pencil first.

Score fold line. Cut out along perforations of border. Place coloured paper inside with double sided tape. Use fancy scissors to cut around edge.
